The SLP is responsible for implementing speech therapy services in an inclusive pre-school setting for children between the ages of three to five years old through the use of structured assessments, treatment and documentation of clients. Provide screenings and/or evaluations for each child as appropriate in order to determine that child's need for speech/language therapy if the Interagency Child Find cannot provide the service. The SLP shall provide, as determined by the IEP, a written treatment plan for each child diagnosed as needing speech/language services; the plan shall include measurable goals and objectives and meet the school district IEP. The SLP will travel to classrooms and provide inclusive therapy. We offer full time, part time and on-call positions.

Qualifications:

Master's Degree in Speech/Language Pathology with a Clinical Fellowship Year (CFY) or Certificate of Clinical Competency (CCC) required. Must possess or obtain a Colorado Department of Education (CDE Type E Certificate). Candidate must have computer experience, ability to multi-task, patience and excellent communication skills.

Additional Benefits:

Full-time employees receive a competitive benefits package including access to medical, dental and vision insurance, flexible spending accounts and a 401(k) program. CPCD also offers a paid time off program with personal/annual paid time off (similar to paid vacation time), paid sick time, and paid holidays (including some school breaks, such as Thanksgiving Break, Winter Break and Spring Break).

This position follows the school year (August – May), with summers off.
